

Your questions regarding the 50 hour work placement requirement for the CHC81115 Graduate Diploma of Family Dispute Resolution.

The full qualification and four of the six core units have a mandatory work placement requirement.

Mediator Training Academy Student Work Placement Requirement

50 Hour Work Placement

The requirement is 50 hours and specific work with clients must be completed.

The Mediator Training Academy does not arrange your work placement requirements. However we are delighted to work with your supervisor or supervising organisation if you have your own work placement arranged.



Participants must organise their own placement for 50 hours of supervised FDR practice. A Supervisor's report must be provided to the Mediator Training Academy certifying completion of the 50 hours of practical family dispute resolution mediations. We will provide you with a Supervisors report document to be completed in due course.

If you are working with a FDR provider or have a relationship with a FDR Practitioner they may be able to provide you with a work placement without charging you any money. If you can secure a placement on those terms we are happy to work with you.

Work placement requires a considerable amount of time and effort for your supervising FDR Practitioner(s).

Queensland University of Technology (QUT) - Family mediation practice

QUT has now opened its Family mediation clinic to students of the Mediator Training Academy where people can complete 20 hours towards the 50 hours of supervised FDR practice in its QUT Family Mediation Service at their Kelvin Grove Campus in Brisbane.



The supervision fee is \$2,500.00 (GST free) and they have clients waiting for mediations.
